4. Application with a narrative due on or before 31 December 2017.

6. Scholarships will be used at a post-high-school accredited educational institution.
7. Scholarships will be paid directly to the student and monitored by the VVA432 Scholarship Committee.
8. Judging will take into consideration: financial need, narrative stating your projects, leadership qualities, volunteer commitments, and plans for your future education.
 - A. Three letters of recommendation are required. Suggest letters from principle, guidance counselor, or Teacher/instructor from your school. At least one letter from an adult that is not a relative.
 - B. List memberships in organizations, part time or full time employment, church affiliation, community Volunteer activities and list any special talents you possess within the narrative.
