

Operation Freedom Bird, is a non-profit, providing a unique Healing Journey & therapeutic program aimed at helping Arizona combat veterans, from all wars, continue the process to heal from their symptoms of PTSD and unresolved grief/loss. The four day journey in DC provides an opportunity to share their experiences, and pay tribute to their fallen comrades-in-arms in a supportive environment of fellow Veterans and concerned counselors. Each year, since 1988, approximately 50 veterans have been selected to participate in a four-day Healing Journey. Participants are selected by community counselors throughout Arizona, some of whom also accompany the veterans on the journey. Combat Vets may also apply to participate themselves. In addition to visiting the National Mall War Memorials, the program itinerary includes a trip to Arlington National Cemetery, the Iwo Jima Memorial, and the 9-11 Memorial located at the Pentagon.

The Operation Freedom Bird Healing Journey's primary goal is to be victorious in ending the war after the war. This war goes by many names; PTSD, Moral Injury, Grief/Loss. At 22 Veterans who suicide everyday it is a National epidemic.
